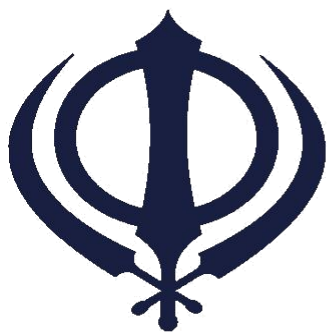
Please remember that parents are only allowed to bring in fruit for their child's class to share. Toys and gift bags are not allowed and will not be given out.
