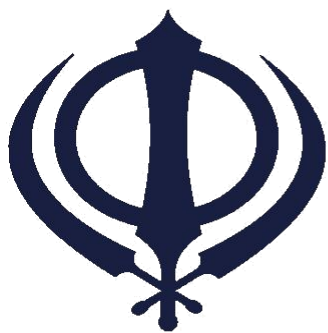
World Book Day
