

#### Nursery & Reception Admissions 2019- 20

Admissions for Nursery and Reception 2019 - 20 are now open so that parents can make applications. **The deadline is 15th January 2019.** Please make sure that your applications are in on time.

Parents of current Nursery children will receive packs from our nursery staff for admission to Reception during next week. On **Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> October at 8.50am**, there will be an 'Open Morning' to provide essential information for making applications. All Nursery parents **must** attend the meeting. Please note that a current Nursery place does not guarantee a place in Reception. Parents will need to re-apply for a Reception place. Please see Mrs. Kaur in the school office for more information.

#### Home Learning

We have revised our approach to home learning to enable pupils to further develop independent learning, thinking and research skills. Our aim is for parents and children to work collaboratively at home. Parents will find details of project style tasks in home learning books for children to complete by the end of autumn term. Please work with your child and support them so that all the tasks are completed at a good level. Children will receive a certificate at the end of the term, if they complete all the tasks.

On a daily basis, parents need to read with their children and sign the reading record. Children will also need to learn spellings and times tables on a weekly basis.

#### Uniform

Please note the new school uniform must be bought from Tesco only, and not any other supplier. We would prefer the children to wear the old uniform whilst they are waiting for a delivery from Tesco, instead of wearing uniform bought from another supplier. Tesco kindly donate 5% commission on uniform sale towards our pupils' educational resources.

To enable the admin staff to deal efficiently with the busy morning and afternoon sessions, parents and carers are expected to leave messages on the answer machine as opposed to speaking to a member of staff. When you call, please select the 'pupil absent' option and leave a clear, short message. All messages left will be dealt with ASAP.
