Absences

Attendance

We all know that good attendance and punctuality are both essential for children to make good progress in their learning and to achieve well. Long or frequent absences disrupt learning and it is very difficult for children to catch up on what has been missed. Parents and carers have a duty to ensure that their children attend school regularly and on time. The attendance target for all children is 96% and the school's overall target is 97%. The school will intervene if a pupil's level of attendance is lower than the level required for efficient full-time education. Please remember not to take holidays during term time as these will not be authorised.

Collecting Children & Authorisation

Please note that we cannot accept last minute phone calls to authorise the collection of your child to any individual who does not appear on the collection list. We can only send children home with people who are authorised.

London History Day

London History Day will take place in May. At Khalsa Primary, we will be celebrating on **Thursday 24th May** and we are encouraging the children to 'Dress as a Londoner'. This is a great chance for us to celebrate the fact that we are a school in London and also promote British values. The overall theme is **courage**, so please plan for the children's outfits to relate to historic individuals in London who have shown courage and bravery. Please bring £1 in to donate towards school fund as it will be a 'non-uniform' day.

Summer Weather & Hay fever
