## Years 2 and 6 Standard Assessment Tests and Tasks (SATs)

Thank you to all parents and carers for their support for their children. Please continue to support your children by praising them and encouraging them to do their very best. It's essential that the children have a healthy breakfast every day at home or at school and attend school regularly and on time.

## Uniform

Please ensure that your child wears the correct school uniform every day. Girls are allowed to wear summer dresses. It is essential that the dress is navy blue, pure cotton checked school dress with navy blue leggings.

## London History Day

Parents are reminded that we will be celebrating 'London History Day' on **Thursday 23rd May**. We are asking all children to 'dress up'. This is a great chance for us to promote British Values. As it will be a 'non-uniform day' we are asking children to donate £1.00, which will go towards school fund.

## London Smagam

We are reminding parents that the school will take an active part in the London Smagam on **Friday 24th May**. Some of the classes will be fortunate enough to welcome Guru Granth Sahib Ji at the start of the Smagam around 12.00pm. All the children will walk over to the Norwood Field in the afternoon to recite poems and sing shabads. They will have a snack as part of langar. It is important that sun cream is applied and pupils affected by hay fever are given medication at the start of the school day. ## Parking

Parents are reminded to park with care and consideration for our neighbours and the safety of everyone. Some parents have been blocking driveways and causing disruption. Car registration numbers are being noted and the police have been informed.
