Can we please remind parents and carers not to use their mobiles on school grounds? This is a requirement for safeguarding purposes.

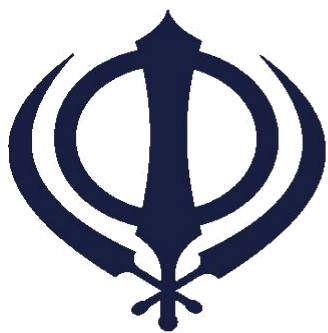
Cakes and Biscuits Sale to Raise Funds for Macmillan Cancer Support
