

What is first aid?

First aid is ...

- * the immediate medical assistance given to an injured person.
- * given to a person who has been hurt or is suddenly taken ill.
- * the first steps taken before a person gets expert medical help if required.
- * First aid can sometime save a persons life, but more often it is help given in everyday accident or illness.

Pupils in school who require medication will fall into three broad groups

1) Those who are completing a course of prescribed medication

- 2) Those who have a long term medical condition
- 3) Those with condition that can, often without warning, require swift emergency medication

Prescribed medication

- * Only prescribed medications is administered to the child.
- * Once the consent form has been filled by the parent it is then there responsibility to hand and collect the prescribed medication from the school office.
- * Medications must be handed to the child.
- * Class teacher is made aware that medication will be administered for xx days

Long term medical condition

*Asthma*Diabetics*Epilepsy

- * We check all registration forms to check any child suffering from long term medical condition
- * We speak to parents and ask for medication and health care form to be kept at school
- * We invite a nurse for further advice and support if needed
- * We make staff aware of condition
- * It is the parents responsibility of any changes in any medications handed to school



For all we do keep records
