Visit to the Roald Dahl Museum

On **Monday 4th December 2017**, Year 3 children will be visiting the Roald Dahl Museum. The purpose of this visit is for the children to gain insight into the life and works of the author Roald Dahl. The children will be involved in a workshop titled, 'Crafting Characters' at the Museum. They will discover how Roald Dahl found his ideas for creating characters and have the chance to create their own characters. Furthermore, we will also be going on a Village Trail Tour around the village where the Museum is situated, to learn more about Roald Dahl.

We will be leaving school at 9.00am and hope to return by 3.15pm. The children will be accompanied and supervised by adults throughout the entire visit and every care will be taken to ensure the safety and welfare of your child.

The children will need to bring their own packed lunch in a plastic bag, labelled with their name. Children who are entitled to a free school meal will be provided with a packed lunch by Harrisons. Please also make sure that appropriate clothing is worn, for example coats/jackets, hats and scarfs.
