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## Attendance & Punctuality

- It's also essential that children come to school on time. Lateness will be recorded on the register and there will be follow up action.

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## Reading

- We want the children to develop a love for reading.
- Please read with your child at home every day. Ask them questions about the book.
- **It's essential that parents write comments in their child's reading record book**
- Please take your child to the library and encourage them to read a range of different texts.



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## Physical Education

- Children are required to bring in a **clean** P.E. kit at the start of the half term
- PE bags will be kept in school until the end of each half term. At half term it's important that the PE is washed and returned to school.
- Please ensure that children's kit fits them and has their name clearly written.



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## Home Learning

- 'Home learning' include a wide range of work - e.g. spellings, handwriting, reading, numeracy work.
- Please ensure that you support your child with the home work. It is important that the work is completed and brought into school on time.
- Children must read on a daily basis. Please ensure that you support your child.
- Homework will be given to children on a Friday. It is due back the following Tuesday.



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## Water Bottles and Fruit

- Children are required to bring a water bottle to school which will be kept in the classroom.
- Children in Nursery, reception, years 1 & 2 receive fruit. If you would like your child to have fruit, please provide them with fruit
- Please ensure that you label water bottles & fruit boxes
- If your child brings in a packed lunch, then please make sure that they bring in a separate water bottle & fruit box
- Children in Nursery and Reception get free milk. For other year groups, parents can contact 'Cool Milk' so that their children receives milk



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## Home Time

- Please collect children from their specified location
- Year 2 children are to be collected from the hall. They will remain in a line until the class teacher sees the parent and will then send out the children.
