Coronavirus

Thank you to parents and carers for their support and understanding, during this challenging period.

We would like to reassure parents and carers that we are closely following guidance from the Local Authority. The school will remain open until or unless we are advised otherwise by the government.

To ensure that children are safe whilst they are at school we are ensuring that they wash their hands very often. The following key points have been shared with the children on a daily basis:

- Wash your hands with soap and water as often as you can.
- Do not touch your eyes, nose or mouth
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze.
- Put used tissues in the bin straight away.

We are reassuring the children by sharing information about the coronavirus, which is appropriate to their age.

To help protect the school community, we are requesting parents not to enter the school building unless absolutely necessary. If you do need to come in we are requesting you wash your hands before entering the school premises. Hand wash facilities are available outside in the playground.

- boxes of tissues
- anti-bacterial wipes
- kitchen rolls (to help clean surfaces)
