COVID-19

If anyone in your household has any of the symptoms of COVID-19, you must all selfisolate immediately. You <u>must not</u> send your child to school.

These are the COVID-19 symptoms:

- A high temperature
- A new, continuous cough
- A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste

COVID-19 cases in school

As you are aware, we have had more than one 'bubble' closed due to positive COVID cases. We wish to reassure parents that we are following all government and Public Health England guidance in our COVID procedures and we only close 'bubbles' in response to their advice and guidance.

The COVID-19 cases are not related to each other and we are confident that transmission has not occurred at school between different 'bubbles'; transmission of the virus is occurring within families / local communities. If a member of your household is displaying symptoms of COVID-19, the whole family should self-isolate until you receive the result of the test. Children <u>must not</u> be sent to school whilst other family members are awaiting test results.

If you send your child to school whilst someone in your household is displaying COVID symptoms, you are putting other families at risk.

Cold Weather

Please make sure that your child is dressed appropriately for the weather with coats, hats, gloves, scarves and so on. Each item should be clearly labelled with the child's name. With the current Coronavirus situation, we must keep windows open to ventilate classrooms. Therefore please dress your child appropriately.
