COVID-19

COVID 19 - National Lockdown

Remember to wash your hands regularly and also remind your children and maintain social distance.

In-school Provision for Children of Critical Workers and Vulnerable Children

Please remember that you <u>must not</u> send your child to school if anyone in the household has any symptoms of COVID-19. If you send your child into critical worker provision when someone in your household has symptoms, you are contributing to the spread of the virus and putting other families at risk.

Free School Meals

For those children who are eligible for Free School Meals, you should by now have received your vouchers by email. If you have any queries about the voucher scheme, or have not received yours and you know your child is entitled to Free School Meals, please contact the school office.

If you think that you might be eligible for Free School Meals, please apply directly through the Local Authority, who will then inform the school of your entitlement.
