COVID-19

In-school provision for children of critical workers and vulnerable children

Our school is still open to these pupils and we are pleased that, so far, we have been able to offer a place to all those who need it. Whilst we are currently able to offer this provision to those who have requested it, parents need to be aware that if the number of requests increases, we may then experience issues with staffing. If this does happen, a place may be withdrawn and pupils will need to return to home learning.

Free School Meals

For those children who are eligible for means-tested, a national voucher system is now in place. Parents whose children are eligible for this scheme should shortly receive an email from Edenred. If you have any queries about the voucher scheme, or you do not know if your child is entitled to Free School Meals, please contact the school office.

If you think that you might be eligible for Free School Meals, please apply directly through the Local Authority.

Devices
