- A high temperature
- A new, continuous cough
- A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste

# COVID-19 testing for households and bubbles of school pupils

As we informed parents last week, households, childcare and support bubbles of primary school pupils will now have regular access to a twice-weekly 'lateral flow' COVID-19 tests. This allows for COVID testing where the adult does not have any COVID symptoms. These can be accessed in the following ways:
