# School COVID-19 procedures – a reminder

We would like to remind parents and carers that COVID-19 is still a risk to our community and we all need to remain vigilant. If your child, or anyone in your household has any of these symptoms, you must isolate and take a COVID test.

- A new, persistent cough
- A high temperature
- A loss of taste or smell

Do not send your child into school if someone in the household is waiting for test results.

#### COVID-19 testing

Remember that asymptomatic testing ('Lateral Flow Tests') is now available for all adults who live in a household with primary school pupils. Tests can be ordered online or from a local testing centre.


