Uniform

We have noticed that a number of pupils are continuing to wear the incorrect uniform, especially footwear. On the day when they have PE, pupils must wear their uniform to school and bring their PE kit with them. They must wear patkas and school shoes. If this is persistent, we will be calling parents to come into school and bring the correct items of uniform.

Punctuality

A number of pupils are coming to school late on a regular basis. This is extremely disruptive to them and to the other pupils. We would like to remind parents that they must ensure that their child gets to school on time every day. The gates are open from 8.25 – 8.35 am. Pupils arriving in class after 8.40 am will be marked late.

Sewa Week – 21st June

During the week of 21st June, there will be a whole school focus on the importance of sewa as we want the children to develop some understanding of the true meaning of selfless service. Therefore, all year groups will be given opportunities to participate in different types of sewa during the school day. Please talk to your child about the importance of sewa and encourage them to carry out selfless service at home.

Break Time Snacks

We would like to remind parents that if they are providing a snack for their child to eat at break time, this can only be either fresh fruit or vegetables. Please do not send pupils in with biscuits, yoghurts, cheese or anything else.

Year 5 and 6 pupils travelling alone

We would like to remind parents that year 5 and 6 pupils can leave the school premises alone if written permission is given. If you choose to do this, you must remind your children about the importance of conducting themselves properly on the way home. They must continue to behave in line with our school rules and be able to travel home safely and sensibly.

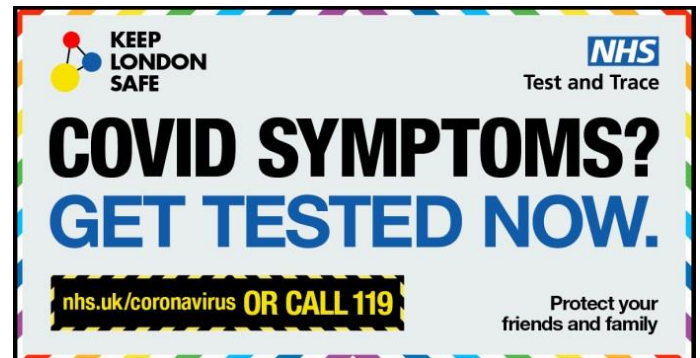
