Monday 19th September – Bank Holiday for Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II's state funeral

It has now been announced that Monday 19th September will be a bank holiday. As such, school will be closed.

If your child attends a club on Mondays, we will make up for this by having the extra session on the last Monday of term (Monday 12th December).

COVID-19

We would like to remind parents that COVID-19 cases are rising again. Please be vigilant and keep your child off school if they have any symptoms. If your child tests positive for COVID, please keep them off school and let us know by calling the school office or sending an email.

Polio Vaccinations

Following the detection of polio virus in sewage samples from Beckton (which covers north and east London) in 2022, the Joint Committee on Vaccination and Immunisation (JCVI) has recommended an urgent inactivated polio vaccine booster campaign for all children aged one to nine in London to supplement the catch-up campaign already underway across the city.

All children aged one to nine in Ealing will be offered a supplementary dose of polio vaccine starting in August 2022, except for those who have received their pre-school booster in the past 12 months.

The vaccination campaign will begin in all London boroughs as rapidly as possible. The link to the attached leaflet can be found here:
