Nursery & Reception Admissions 2023-24

Admissions for Nursery and Reception 2022-23 are now open so that parents can make applications. The deadline is **15**th **January 2023**. Please make sure that your applications are in on time. Parents need to apply online through the Ealing website, and also complete the Supplementary Information Form, which can be found on our school website.

We will be holding two open mornings this term on the following dates:

Friday 14th October at 8.45am – Reception open morning

Friday 21st October at 8.45am – Nursery open morning

It is vital that parents attend these sessions to find out key information about how to apply. Please note that if your child attends our Nursery, you must still apply for Reception. You are not guaranteed a place.

Punctuality

We have noticed that a significant number of pupils are arriving late to school on a regular basis. This is extremely unsettling for the child and very disruptive for the teachers. If you arrive at school late (8.45am onwards) you must bring your child into the school office to sign them in and explain why you are late. If this happens on a regular basis, you may be called into school to meet with the headteacher or even the Local Authority Attendance team.

Collection from school

We would like to remind parents about the procedures for collecting their child from school. It is vital that these procedures are followed for the child's safety.

- Your child must be collected by an adult whose name we have on record. If you wish to change your collection list, please see school office.
- Your child must be collected on time every day at 3.20pm. Persistent lateness will be noted down and parents may be called in to meet with the headteacher.
- Once you have collected your child, you must walk safely out of the school grounds together. It is not permitted for children to climb on the school play equipment or cycle / scoot on school grounds.
- 4. We recommend that you hold your child's hand and walk together on the way home / to the bus or car. Do not let your child run or walk off ahead of you.
- 5. If your child is in year 5 or year 6, you may give permission for them to go home alone. This permission must be given in writing by letter or email.

These measures are in place to protect children and it is very important that everyone follows them.

Clothing

A number of pupils are still coming to school without a coat, or even a jumper. It is now getting colder and often rains during the day. You must send your child to school with appropriate clothing for the weather.
