Picking up children at end of day – an important reminder

If you want to change the names on your consent list, please come to the school office. If your child is in year 5 or 6, you may give permission (in writing) for them to go home alone.

Pupil Absence and Punctuality

We have noticed that a number of pupils are absent from school very regularly. Parents need to be aware that absences have a significant impact on children's progress in learning and children should only be absent from school when they are too unwell to attend.

Pupils should also come to school on time every day. Being late to school is detrimental to children's well-being and makes them feel anxious and unsettled.
