If you would like to come and take some food from the foodbank, completely free of charge, please come to the side door of school (next to the school office) at any time from 2.15 – 3.15pm. This is a completely free, confidential and discreet service and is available to any families who need it.

We will also need volunteers to help organise the donations during the week. If you would like to volunteer, please give your name to the school office and Ms Butler will be in touch with you shortly.
