However, the attendance of some pupils does remain a concern. We would like to remind parents that your child must be in school every day, unless they are too ill to do so. If your child is sick, please call the school office or send an email first thing in the morning.

Term-time holidays are not permitted. If you take your child out of school on holiday, you will be fined and reported to the Education Welfare Officer.
