## British Values Assembly Theme – Individual Liberty

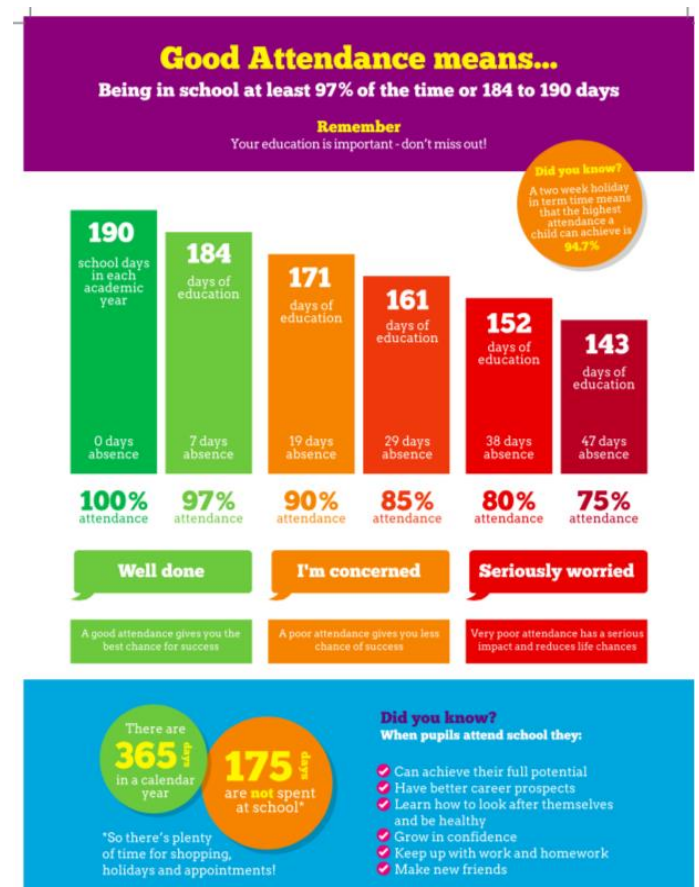
