

We are pleased to be able to share with you the curriculum content which your child will cover this term. This term looks different, as the key focus will be to prepare your child for the SATs.

**SATs dates:**  
**Monday 12<sup>th</sup> May 2025** - English grammar, punctuation and spelling papers 1 and 2  
**Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> May 2025** - English reading  
**Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> May 2025** - Mathematics papers 1 and 2  
**Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> May 2025** - Mathematics paper 3

**English – Reading**  
 This term, we are focusing on revision for SATs and will be using the CGP books.  
  
 In reading lessons, children will continue to develop their skills with retrieval and inference. They will read and understand a variety of fiction, non-fiction and poetry texts.  
  
 Parents can help at home by reading with their child and signing their reading record every day.

**English – Writing**  
**Writing to Inform** – An explanation report about how the Mayan pyramids were built.  
  
**Writing to Entertain** – A character description based on Wonder.  
  
 We will be spending time editing and improving all our writing pieces for the year, using the grammar techniques learnt.

**Mathematics:**  
 This half-term we will be revising the following topics:

- Area, Perimeter and Volume
- Averages
- Properties of shape
- Measures
- Length, Mass, Capacity
- Position and Direction
- Statistics
- Charts, Graphs, Averages
- 4 Operations
- Fractions, Decimals, Percentages
- (Roman Numerals)
- Time
- Ratio and Proportion
- Algebra

 By the end of this term, children will recognise who the significant modern Sikhs are worldwide, from the U.K.


**Spellings:**

- **Year 5 and 6 statutory spelling words**

**Grammar:**  
 We will continue to build on and expand upon the children's knowledge of grammar, looking especially this term at:

- root words, prefixes, suffixes/word endings

**Arithmetic:**  
 Continued revision of the four mental operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.  
  
**Reasoning:**  
 Children will revise their knowledge and put their mathematical skills to use through logic and making connections. They will practice reading and decoding SAT's style questions.



**PSHE – Positive relationships**  
  
 We will be considering what makes a good friend, reflecting on themselves and how they think they will be remembered at Khalsa. Looking ahead, children will explore how friendship groups can change as we grow older and our personalities change. They will create a list of non-negotiables for a friendship and think about how they can create positive relationships in the future with new people as they move on to different schools.

**Computing – Computer Science – Can you give instructions?**  
  
 Children will be able to identify a bug, be able to explain what type of error it is and explain why this error makes a difference to the outcome.

**Physical Education – Friday afternoon**  
 This term, pupils will focus on Athletics and Gymnastics. Please ensure that they have the correct PE kit with them every week.
