English – Reading

This term, we are reading the novel: *The Minpins and Beware of Boys*.

In reading lessons, children will continue to develop their skills with retrieval and inference. They will read a variety of fiction, non-fiction and poetry texts.

Parents can help at home by reading with their child and signing their reading record every day.

English – Writing

Writing to entertain – we will be writing an alternative ended to the story of the *Minpins*, a fantastic book by Roald Dahl.

Writing to inform – we will write fictional instructions based on *Beware of Boys* by Tony Blundell.

Grammar

We will continue to build on and expand upon the children's knowledge of grammar, looking especially this term at embedding capital letters, full stops and inverted commas.

Our focus will be on ensuring pupils are able to correctly use a capital letter and full stop.

- Adding suffixes beginning with vowels


Mathematics

This half term we will cover the following topics:

We will be learning all about the process of rock formation.
