English: Reading

This term, we are continuing reading the novel: The Witches by Roald Dahl.

In reading lessons, children will continue to develop their skills with retrieval and inference. They will read a variety of fiction, non-fiction and poetry texts.

Parents can help at home by reading with their child and signing their reading record every day.

English: Writing

This term, we will focus on writing a persuasive letter and a write and design a leaflet that persuades and audience to visit a place of significance.

Grammar

We will continue to build on and expand upon the children's knowledge of grammar, looking especially this term at:

- First and second person
- Modal verbs
- Subordinate conjunctions

Spellings:

Explore all spelling rules learnt this year and ensure rules have been clearly embedded.

Mathematics:

This half term we will cover the following topics:

- Time
- Properties of shape
- Statistics

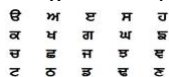

Science: What can we do with magnets?

We will be learning how magnets work and how friction effects pushes and pulls. Pupils will go into detail on:

- how to compare and contrast push and pull forces.
- identify and group materials.
- show our findings in a written investigative science report.

Physical Education:

This term, pupils will focus on cricket and Dance. Please ensure that the have the correct PE kit with them every week.

Sikh Studies: What is Daswand?

By the end of this term, pupils will learn about the concept of Daswand:

- The role of Sikh charities
- The role of charities.
- Create their own charity and explain the purpose of it. They will learn all about their contributions to Sikhi.

Geography: How do we evaluate land use?

Pupils will explore and research how the land of a country is divided and used according to its climate by:

- Comparing sources and data for information and statistics.
- Compare and suggest reasons for growth of cities.

Religious Education: What does it mean to be Christian?

Pupils will continue with the understanding of the meaning and values of Christianity to Christians.

Finding further examples of Jesus and Jesus life from the Gospels in the Bible.

Computing: How do we give instructions to a computer?

Pupils will demonstrate logical 'trial and error' when using a computer simulation and then be able to produce an accurate set of simple instructions. They will also create their own game using coded sequences along with clear instructions.

PSHE: This term in PSHE, we will continue the focus on:

- Positive relationships
- Looking after our world
- Looking out for ourselves and others

We will discuss the importance of maintaining positive relationships.

DT: Making a magnetic game.

We will research how magnetic games work and Gather ideas for our own magnetic games. We will plan, create and evaluate our final product giving ideas for improvement if necessary.
