Other assessments

Summer term is a busy time for assessments, with pupils in a number of year groups taking part in national assessments. They have all been well-prepared for these by teachers and teaching assistants and we are confident that all of the pupils are ready.

Summer tests for key year groups are as follows:

Year 1 – Phonics Screening Check - week beginning 8th June

Year 2 – SATs tests – ongoing during May

Year 4 – Multiplication Tables Check – week beginning 1st June
